



Your personal data in the NMTT

Information on you – your personal data – is important to companies that produce goods and services for you. Personal data will enable companies to develop and improve goods and services that meet your needs and preferences.

EU has adopted a regulation¹ to ensure that you as the owner of your personal data are the one who decides who should get your personal data and how your personal data are used and to what purposes they are used.

When you have given your permission to use your data the user is obliged to take care of it. The user cannot give your data away or sell it without your permission.

NMTT has the following personal data on members and friends of the NMTT: name, e-mail address and for some members also the telephone number. This information will be updated and/or deleted when you want it.

NMTT uses the personal information to inform on NMTT activities such as the invitation to the NMTT General Assembly, Newsletter, publications and NMTT activities that might interest members and friends of the NMTT.

For NMTT members and others working and participating in NMTT projects the NMTT needs additional personal data such as bank accounts or documents on expenses. The NMTT stores these data as long as NMTT as requested by donors or others.

EU member states ensure that these EU-rules on personal data protection are respected. NMTT is registered in Denmark. In Denmark The Danish Data Protection Agency supervises compliance with the EU Data regulation.
